- Excursions and field trips - Incineration and water purification plants Koksov-Baksa, Vojany Thermal Power Plant, Slovak Magnesite Plants in Jelsava, Cement factory in Turna, Lubenik Magnesite Plant, Permaculture Association Site in Revuca, Tichy potok area (planned water reservoir dam site) and culturally oriented excursions to geologically, geographically and culturally interesting sites (Spis Castle, the Drevenik, reservation, the Zehra early gothic church, Levoca city, Spisska Kapitula romanesque church and fortification, the Siva brada mineral springs, the Lacnov valley)
- Cultural events - special concert of the "Fountains" musical ensemble from Prague (Czech Republic), etc.

**Number of participants:** 16 (Italy, France, Spain, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Slovakia)

### Focus:

- to become acquainted with historical, cultural and archaeological heritage of the region, problems of religious cultural heritage preservation
- practical contribution to the preservation of historical monuments
- raising awareness of the public in the field of historical monuments preservation
- to promote European spirit of cooperation promotion of Eastern Slovakia and its cultural heritage abroad
- creation of local network of cooperating institutions and individuals in the field of cultural heritage
- promotion of the idea of European Heritage Campuses in Slovakia

### The campus consisted of:

- Theoretical part - lectures and discussions (2 days)
- Excursions to the region of Gemer and Spis and the field trip to Tichy potok area (2 days)
- Practical works on two working places: 1) the Church of St. John from Nepomuk in the village Byster, 2) the Chapel at the Cemetery Rozalia, Kosice.
